2011 is the 400<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first publication of the King James Version of the Bible. It is common knowledge that the translation project was commissioned at a conference convened by King James I of England, at Hampton Court in January 1604. But, not so many people know that it was in May 1601 that the same king, James VI of Scotland, attended the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland at St Columba's Church in Burntisland, Fife, where the proposal for a new translation of the Bible into English was first put forward!

Using the KJV 400<sup>th</sup> anniversary as a springboard, [Biblefresh](#) is a cross-denominational initiative with a vision to reignite and re-enthuse the church in its passion for the Bible. What better personal and corporate goal for 2011 could there be than this?!

The internet offers many resources and opportunities to help us get to grips with God's Word. This year, Precept Scotland has been pioneering the use of 'Skype' video-conferencing as a tool for on-line Bible study – [contact us](#) for more information. The Bible Society has just issued a free recording of the entire New Testament, comprising 40 half-hour episodes performed by the 'Riding Lights' Christian theatre, which can be down-loaded [here](#). 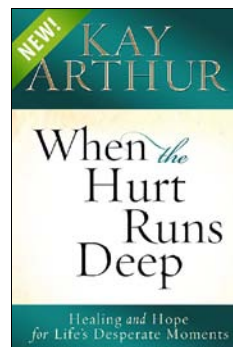
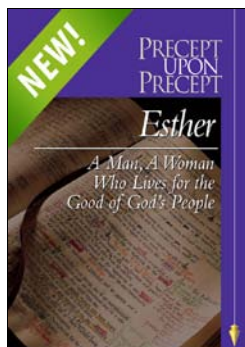
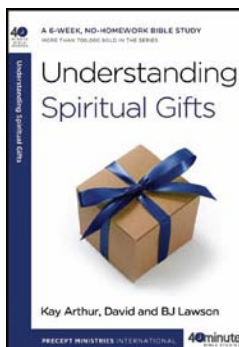


### 'BIBLICAL PRAYER' WORKSHOP – SATURDAY 20 NOVEMBER 2010
